




Sponsored Funding (with COVID 19)






Sponsored Funding (Without COVID 19)






College/Division Funding Trends (with COVID 19)




Proposals by # and \$ (With Covid 19)






Proposals by # and \$ (Without COVID 19)





Composition of Funding by Source






Composition Determined by Originating Source

- Sponsored proposal and award volume continues to increase, with a 72% increase since FY 2019
- Federal funds account for most sponsored funding, but direct State funding is increasing
