Community College: National Picture

- Community College enrollment numbers are boosted by the growth in high school enrollment for dual credit (20% of overall community college enrollment) I'd
- 50% of all Hispanic and 40% of all Black students in higher education are enrolled at community colleges
- 80% percent of students who enroll in community colleges plan on getting a bachelor's degree but only around 15% do so within six years
- 43% of credits are lost between two-year colleges and four- year institutions





Transfer Credit Estimator

- Went live July 17, 2023
- From July 17-September 10:
 - 977 total user sessions including 219 unique student users
 - 173 accounts created and then turned into transfer prospects
 - 1,567 courses have been added to the tool



Transfer Enrollment

- Of the 3,527 students entering in fall 2023, 37.6% were new transfer students, up from 34% in 2022.
- Transfer students make about 12% of total undergraduate enrollment.
 - 73% from community colleges
- About half of new transfers have earned some credit but not an associate's degree/60 credits (55.8% in Fall 2022).




First Generation Status – Fall 2023




Serve Workforce Serve Place-Bound Needs Students



NIU at Rock Valley College

- Engineer shortage in the region
- Launched in fall 2016
- Paid internships and scholarships
- 100% of graduates employed in regional companies or pursuing graduate degrees
- 40+ interns have worked in 18 regional companies
- 98 graduates to date





NIU at Elgin Community College

Targeted initiative to address shortage of bilingual teachers

- Elementary Education
 53 graduated
 38 currently enrolled
 100% on-time graduation rate
- Early Childhood Education
 28 currently enrolled








- Launched Fall 2019
- Programs:
 - Computer Science
 - Psychology
 - Marketing (New Degree Program Spring 2024 TBD)
- Overall retention is 79%
- 112 students have graduated (45 in Computer Science, 57 in Psychology and 10 in Marketing)
