

Mullick Family Scholarship in Engineering

The purpose of the scholarship is to provide assistance to students pursuing and seeking a degree from the College of Engineering and Engineering Technology.

The Award

\$1,500 for one semester

Eligibility

The preferred recipient(s):

- Must be majoring in Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, or Industrial and Systems Engineering in the College of Engineering and Engineering Technology, and
- Must be a full-time, undergraduate, degree-seeking student, and has completed a minimum of thirty semester hours, and
- Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater
- Primary consideration will be given to first-generation students with demonstrated financial need.
- Additional consideration will be given students engaged in extracurricular activities with the college or the university.
- The selection of recipient(s) will be made under the guidance of the dean of the College of Engineering and Engineering Technology or his/her successor at Northern Illinois University (hereinafter, "University") utilizing an appropriate committee approved by the dean.
- In the event a recipient, prior to receiving the scholarship funds, withdraws from the University or is no longer qualified under the criteria outlined in this Agreement, the funds allocated for the scholarship may be granted to another qualified student.

About the Donor

The Mullick Family Scholarship in Engineering was started by Virendra and Kamla Mullick in conjunction with their sons, Vivek (BSIE '96) and Vinay (BSIE '00).
